

Course title	SERBIAN SECURITY POLICIES

Short description of the course	At the beginning of the course, students will be introduced to the concept of security as a public good and public policy. It will be especially important for students to understand internal and international security as a public good and security policies as public policies. After that, students will get acquainted with the national security system, the legal and strategic framework of security policies and the decision-making process in this area. Students will then be introduced to foreign policy, defense policy, internal affairs policy, intelligence policy, cyber security policy, emergency response as well as security aspects of other public policies such as environmental (environmental safety), agricultural (food safety), social (safety at work, etc.) and other public policies.
